

Wood - Veneer

General Care & Maintenance

Dust timber surfaces regularly with a soft microfibre cloth to remove dirt and debris.

Clean surface of timber with a damp cloth and a mild environmentally friendly soap solution if needed, and thoroughly dry the surface after cleaning. Do not use harsh chemicals, bleach, vinegar or other products that contain silicon, as these can be damaging to the wood surface finishes. Avoid using any abrasive cleaning solutions or scouring pads, as these are likely to damage the wooden surface.

Do not place hot or cold objects directly on wooden surfaces, as this can leave marks or stains. Always try to use coasters to avoid stains and marks.

Light Exposure

To avoid fading, cracking or warping, do not expose material to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight or harsh humidity.

Fabrics & Upholstery

General Care & Maintenance

Dust and dirt can damage the fibres of upholstery, while also add to the dulling of the colours and tones. To maintain the life and vibrancy of your fabrics be sure to vacuum regularly and if exposed to spills or stains rinse with clean lukewarm water and if required a mild upholstery cleaner, following the manufacturers instructions.

When removing stains, gently patt the effected area, working from the outside towards the centre of the spill. Once the stain has been removed, repeat the same process with warm water to remove any residual detergent from the fabric, and dry the area with a dry cloth as best as possible.

Protect your upholstery fabric from direct sunlight, heat sources such as radiators, fireplaces, or candles, and sharp objects that can fade, burn, or tear the fabric

Assembly

General Care & Maintenance

Over time and through use, screws can tend to loosen, so we recommend if you start to feel movement in your product or can hear a squeak, a quick tightening of each screw with the provided allen key will resolve the issue.

Wood - Solid

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Light Exposure

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In the case of significant damage, solid timber can be sanded down and recoated in a timber lacquer. In this instance, this restoration work should be under taken by a professional.

Leathers

General Care & Maintenance

Clean your leather regularly with a damp cloth to remove dirt and dust. Avoid using soap, detergent, or other chemicals that can damage the leather's natural oils and cause it to deteriorate.

Dry your leather slowly at room temperature if it gets wet. Do not expose it to direct heat or sunlight, as this can make the leather brittle and crack. Moisturize your leather periodically with a leather dressing or cream to prevent it from drying out and cracking. Choose a product that is suitable for your type of leather and follow the manufacturer's instructions.

Store your leather in a cool, dry place away from humidity and sunlight. Do not wrap it in plastic, as this can prevent air circulation and cause mold or mildew to grow on the leather

Polish your leather if it has a shiny finish to restore its luster and protect it from scratches. Use a soft cloth and a leather polish that matches the color of your leather.

Brush your suede leather with a suede brush to remove dirt and restore its nap. Avoid getting suede wet, as this can cause stains and damage the texture of the leather.
